

Sun West School Division/MySchoolSask Communication Bulletin

As many of you are aware, school divisions in Saskatchewan will be moving to a single student information system, MySchoolSask (aka Aspen) by Fall 2019. This system will replace PowerSchool in Sun West Schools. Currently school division teams are in the process of learning about the provincial vision for implementing this system through a series of online meetings every week from November 15 – December 20th. From these meetings and the information gained at these sessions, division teams will create their own implementation plans. One part of our plan is to ensure our schools receive regular updates about MySchoolSask and the Sun West training process and schedule.

As part of our planning process, Sun West has created a MySchoolSask Advisory Committee consisting of division personnel (Shari Martin, Linda Klassen, Sondra Potratz, Vanessa Lewis and James Lowe) and representatives from schools:
