# Citing a website

Lastname, Firstname. "Title of Web Page." *Publishing*

*Organization or Name of Website in Italics*. Publication

date and/or access date if available. URL.



# Citing a Film (usually a documentary)

Lastname, Firstname. *Title of Work*. Format.  
Directed/Performed by Firstname Lastname. Original Release  
Year. City: Studio/Distributor, Video release year.  
Medium.
