

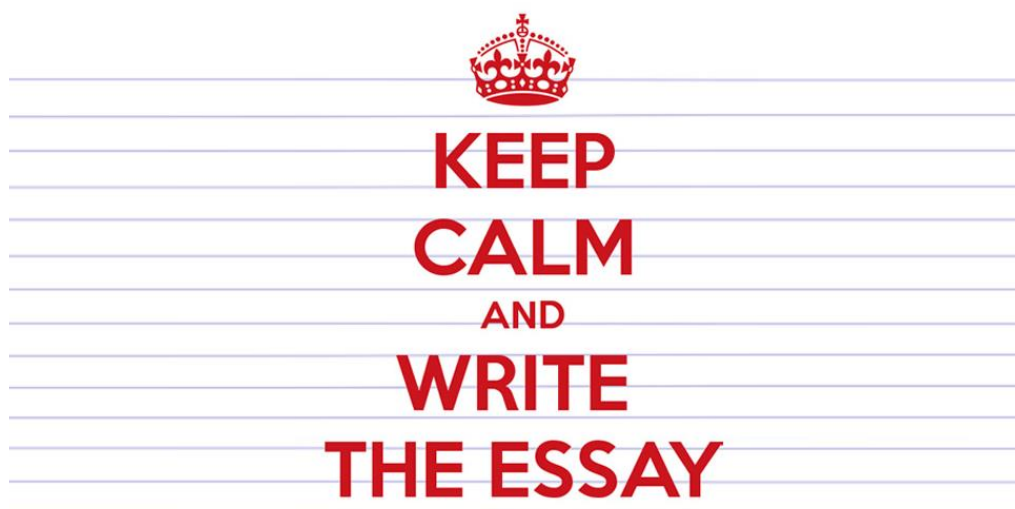
Fairy Tale Assignment

Option 1 – Personal Reflection

Using the fairy tale discussed in class, find three lessons learned and provide examples of:

- How you learned these lessons in your own life,
- How you feel about these lessons,
- Whether or not you believe that these values are something that is relevant to your life,
- If they are valuable, how do you currently ensure that you are exhibiting them, or what can you do to change so that you model the values.
- Other

The sole purpose of this essay is to reflect on your values in relation to those discussed within the literature and the movie. Be sure to indicate if the values and messages in the movie differ, and if they do which one do you relate to more.



Option 2 – Literary Analysis

Using any other fairy tale than the choice discussed in class (clear your selection with teacher **before** beginning), *compare and contrast* an early version with a modern day video of the same story.

The early version may not be the original written creation, but should be from an earlier era. The early version may be another video creation, it does not have to be written literature. If you do select another film, it will need to have been created at least 40 years prior to the modern selection. If a written version is select, provide either a printed copy or a link.

For Both Option 1 and 2

You will need to provide each of the following:

1. **An outline demonstrating pre-planning.** You may use any of the options provided previously in the class, or I can provide you with a new one.
 - a. This outline must be discussed with the teacher prior to beginning your rough draft.
2. **A peer-edited rough copy of the essay.**
 - a. Rough copy should have the five paragraph structure (introduction, three body paragraphs, and conclusion).
 - b. Edits should clearly be identified (use the tracking tool in Microsoft Word, or can be done in pen).
 - c. Name of peer who helped with the editing should be at the top of the first page.
3. **A final good copy** which includes:
 - a. 12 point, Times New Roman font
 - b. 1 inch margins
 - c. Indented paragraphs
 - d. Double Spacing
 - e. MLA formatting and citations.
 - f. Maximum of three pages in length. I will stop reading after three pages, so be sure to be concise.
