Before Reading				
Strategies: Before the reading the child,	Independent	Prompt	Comments:	
Relates prior knowledge/personal experiences to the topic				
Uses basic conventions of a book to locate information (table of contents, page numbers etc.)				
Uses the title and illustrations to make predictions as to what the selection is about				
During Reading				
Strategies: During the reading the child,	Independent	Prompt	Comments:	
Uses the illustration				
Uses knowledge of letter sounds				
Uses word families (rhymes)				
Looks for smaller words within big words				
Reads on (if cannot get a word)				
Makes meaningful word substitutions				
Self-checks for understanding/meaning				
Goes back and rereads				
Reads out loud to help gain meaning				
Makes predictions about what might happen next				
Can explain strategies being used				



Uses voice inflections to indicate knowledge of punctuation					
Uses context to determine the meaning of unknown words					
After					
Strategies: After the reading the child,	Independent	Prompt	Comments:		
Retells the story in proper sequence					
Expresses thoughts and feelings about the story					
Relates personal experiences to the story					
Revises or confirms predictions					
Locates information in the text to support ideas					
Uses basic conventions of a book to locate information					
Follows written directions					
Have Learner demonstrate that they can do these things: Identify the title of a selection
