7. Meeting Community Needs - Eastern Saskatchewan

As the number of villages, towns and cities started to grow in Saskatchewan, so did the needs of those communities. To serve the various needs of residents, stores, offices, churches, fire halls, places of entertainment and other places were constructed. The stories of these communities are reflected in the historic places you will learn about when you answer the questions below. For this set of questions, all of these historic places are located in the eastern part of Saskatchewan (east of Highway 2).

1	The Bekevar Church is located 150 Km east of Regina near the town of Kennedy. What church in Hungary inspired the design of the Bekevar Church? Keyword: Bekevar	the Great Church in Debrecen
2	Using the picture, name two colours found on the Bekevar Church? Keyword: Bekevar	Any two of: white, blue or turquoise, red, black, grey
3	Located in Town of Oxbow, the Greer Block was a prominent office building in the town's business district. Which important businesses were located on the first floor of the building when it opened in 1905? Keyword: Greer	Royal Bank and Post Office
4	The Capital Theatre in the Town of Kamsack is considered an important place for gathering in the community. In addition to showing movies, what other two things is the theatre used for? Keyword: Kamsack	concerts and recitals.
5	Several of the post offices built in the cities and large towns of Saskatchewan during the early 20 th century featured tall towers. Some, like the Post Office in Humboldt, had a round element near the top of the tower. Using the photograph, what was this round element on the tower? Keyword: Humboldt	Clock
6	What is the style of the Post Office in the Town of Humboldt? Keyword: Humboldt	Romanesque Revival style
7	The Yorkton Court House was designed by Maurice Sharon, who was the provincial architect from 1916 to 1930. How many court houses did he design in Saskatchewan? Keyword: Yorkton	ten
8	Railway stations came in different sizes and designs, called classes. The lower the number, the larger and more elaborate the station was. What class was the railway station in the Town of Radville? Keyword: Radville	Second Class
9	Railway stations were often built at the end of a town's main business street. Is the railway station in the Town of Radville on its original site? Keyword: Radville	Yes
10	Built in 1917, the Old Fire Hall and Jail in the Town of Bruno is one of the oldest brick fire halls in Saskatchewan. Where were the bricks that were used to build the fire hall made? Keyword: Bruno	Bruno brick plant

11	The B.A. Garage in the Town of Ogema was built to meet the automotive service needs of the people in Ogema and surrounding area. In what year was the B.A. Garage built? Keyword: Ogema	1925
12	Built in 1901, the Commercial Hotel is one of the Town of Wapella's oldest commercial structures. What was the Commercial Hotel's original (first) name? Keyword: Wapella	Mundell Hotel
13	Located in the Village of Welwyn, southeast of Yorkton, the Harper's Store building has been open since 1910 and is one of the oldest continuously operated stores in Saskatchewan. What type of store is Harper's Store? Keyword: Welwyn	General Store
14	The Stone School in the Town of Yellow Grass, near Weyburn, has served many community needs since it was built in 1903. List two of these uses. Keyword: Yellow	Any two of: school, jail, town hall, rural municipal office, meeting place for the Masons, Order of the Eastern Star, and Lions Club, and the town library.
15	In 1977 a movie was filmed at the Pharmacy Building in the Town of Arcola. What was the name of the movie? Keyword: Arcola	"Who Has Seen the Wind."
