Full Today's movement challenge is: 10 Star Jumps - With a Twist! It's Thursday! That means a cardio-style movement that will have your body working hard, and your heart exclaiming "thank you"! Begin in a squat, with your feet hip-width apart. Jump up and land with your feet wide and your arms up (Star Jump).

Jump again to land back in your squat. Then, do a small hop as you twist in the air and land, still in your squat, facing the right. Quickly hop again to face forward. Repeat the star jump, and the mini squat-jump-twist to the left.

like this! -Don't stop at 10 reps if you have gas left in the tank


